### **Dale A. Ulrich**

Dr Dale A. Ulrich is a professor in the Departments of Movement Sciences and Physical Education in the School of Kinesiology at the University of Michigan. Dale is the Director of the Center for Physical Activity & Health in Pediatric Disabilities at the University of Michigan. He is the author of the Test of Gross Motor Development (TGMD I and II) which is used in more than 7000 school districts in the USA as their primary motor skill assessment. The TGMD has been translated for use in 8 countries. Dale's research has focused on measurement of movement skills in children with and without disabilities, early interventions designed to get infants with Down syndrome walking earlier and better and interacting with their environments, and is currently funded to study interventions designed to promote improved functioning, physical activity, health, and increased community participation in youth with Down syndrome and autism spectrum disorders
