Dr. Greg Reid has been a professor for 39 years in the Department of Kinesiology and Physical Education at McGill University, Montreal, Canada. He holds degrees from McGill, UCLA, and the Pennsylvania State University. His teaching has been in adapted physical activity (APA), motor development, and history. His research has dealt with motor learning and performance of individuals with intellectual disabilities, autism, learning disabilities, ADHD, and developmental coordination disorder. He has also written a number of position papers on research issues in APA. He is currently engaged in historical research. Greg is the former editor of the Adapted Physical Activity Quarterly, the 1997 recipient of the G. Lawrence Rarick Research Award, and an International Fellow of the American Academy of Kinesiology. He is a Fellow and Past-President of the International Federation of Adapted Physical Activity, and Fellow of the North American Society of Health, Physical Education, Recreation, Sport, and Dance.
