She graduated from Hacettepe University in 1976. She completed her Master of Sciences degree in 1979 and her Philosophy of Doctorate degree in 1983 in H.U. Health Sciences Institute. She worked as Assistant Professor in King Saud University, The College of Applied Medical Sciences (KSA CAMS) and as Consultant in Orthotics Section, Physiotherapy Department in King Khalid University Hospital (KHUH), Riyadh, Saudi Arabia between 1984-1990.

She received the Associate Professor degree in 1993 and a position in Marmara University, The School of Physical Education and Sports (SPES) and initiated The Adapted Physical Activity (APA) Certificate Program with her colleagues in 2002, which can be considered as the pioneer in this area in Turkey.

In 2000, she received her Professor Degree and headed the Istanbul University, SPES between 2006-2009, and The APA Certificate Program in IU SPES was also structured during her time. Currently she is teaching in the Department of Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation in Yeditepe University and heading the Department.

She is member of ICHPER-SD, IFAPA, Turkish Neuromuscular Disorders Society and Turkish Physical Therapy Association. She has three books written in native language in the areas of sports biomechanics, upper extremity prosthesis, and orthotics in neuromuscular disorders.
