Karen P. DePauw is Vice President and Dean for Graduate Education and tenured Professor at Virginia Tech in Blacksburg, Virginia. DePauw has held several leadership roles in graduate education including Chair for the Virginia Council of Graduate School (VCGS), President of the Council of Southern Graduate Schools (CSGS), Chair of the Board of Directors of the Council of Graduate Schools (CGS) and member of the GRE Board.

Dr. DePauw is an internationally recognized scholar in the fields of adapted physical activity, disability sport and disability studies. She has published extensively, presented keynote and scholar lectures (more than 150) around the world. Her scholarship has focused on inclusion, equity issues, social construction of disability, and sociology of the body. Throughout her academic career, she has served in leadership positions for national and international associations, received numerous honors and awards and has worked extensively with the United States Olympic Committee, the International Paralympic Committee and the Olympic & Paralympic Congresses since 1984.
