Dr. Ron French earned a Bachelor of Arts and Master of Science in Physical Education with a minor in Biology from Humbolt State University in Northern California. He then received his Doctorate of Education in Special Education with a minor in Educational Administration and Adapted Physical Education at the University of California-Los Angeles. He began his distinguished career as a professor at Brockport College in New York and the University of Utah. He has spent the last 24 years at Texas Woman's University and is currently a Professor in the Department of Kinesiology. Dr. French has received TWU's Cornaro Award and the Piper Professorship. Dr. French has been the Director of a United States Office of Education training grant supporting the master's degree program in Adapted Physical Education for over 20 years. He has received over \$3 million federally supported adapted physical education training grants. Dr. French has taught numerous undergraduate and graduate courses in Adapted Physical Education.
