Perihan Savaş

Born in Fatih district of Aksaray, neighborhood of Istanbul in 1955, Perihan Savaş acted her first role in children's department of Istanbul City Theater when she was 5 years old. Having acted in theaters until 1970 and acted in many plays such as 'Küçük Prenses', 'Romeo-Jüliyet', 'Kibarlık Budalası', Perihan Savaş took place in the film 'Şehzade Simbad Kaf Dağında' in 1971. Beginning her cinema career in the same year, Savaş became a leading actress in a short time thanks to the roles she had in many films. She acted in nearly 120 films. She married İbrahim Tatlıses first; and then she married Yılmaz Zafer. Having one child from each one of her marriages, the actress displayed an exemplary behavior while Yılmaz Zafer was ill. The actress also made television programs along with her roles in TV series. She won the Best Woman Actress award in Antalya Film Festival in 1974 with her role in 'Bedrana'. She also won the 'CIDALC Award' in Czechoslovakia.
