He was born in 1972. He studied in Galatasaray Lycee and Department of Business Management in Boğaziçi University. The ten month period he spent working in a bank was enough for him to understand that 'he needed to earn his living by writing'. He started his motion picture authorship in Antrakt magazine. His articles were published in many magazines and journals such as Sinema and Filmartı. He wrote a column named 'Seyir Defteri' as well as his articles in Sinema, where he still writes. He has two screenplays that were filmed. 'Karışık Pizza' (1996) was directed by Umur Turagay and Cem Özer, Meltem Cumbul and Olgun Şimşek acted in the leading roles. Selma Ergeç and Mehmet Günsür took place in 'Ses' (2010), which was directed by Ümit Ünal. He also worked in the scenario team of the tv series 'Tek Başımıza', which was broadcasted on Star TV in 2011-2012. The short films he co-directed and whose scripts he wrote such as 'Doğum' (2008) and 'Ölüm' (2009) were screened in various national and international festivals and won awards. His first novel titled 'Anne Tut Elimi' was published in 2004 and his second novel 'Büyük Deniz Yükseliyor' was published in 2006 by Doğan Kitap. He gave seminars on screenplays during the activities organized by Anadolu Kültür and UniFilmFest. He did ad writing for a total of 11 years in agencies such as Manajans/JWT, Medina Turgul DDB, RPM Radar and Lowe.
